(*) **“Close contact”** (high risk exposition) of a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 it is defined as:

- a person living in the same house of a COVID-19 case
- a person who has had a direct physical contact with a COVID-19 case (i.e. a handshake)
- a person who has had unprotected direct contact with the secretions of a COVID19 case (e.g., touching used paper handkerchiefs with bare hands)
- a person who had had a direct contact (face to face) with a COVID-19 case, at a distance of less than 2 meters and at least for 15 minutes.
- a person who has been in a closed environment (e.g. classroom, meeting room, hospital waiting room) with a COVID-19 case in the absence of suitable PPE
- a health professional or any other person providing direct assistance to a COVID-19 case or laboratory personnel handling samples of a COVID-19 case without the use of recommended PPE or by using unsuitable PPE
- a person who has been seated in a train, plane or in any other means of transport within two seats in any direction of a COVID-case19; travelling companions and staff from the section of the aircraft/train where the index case was sitting are also to be considered in close contact
